# Germany Beck Project

## Weeks 22 & 23 commencing 7th November

During the past 2 weeks we have continued to import stone to create the carriageway embankments to the east of Fordlands Road. The wagons bringing the stone to site have then been loaded with the stockpiled sandy material excavated to create the water meadow. Using the same wagons helps to keep the numbers of wagons on the road to a minimum.



During the next two weeks we will continue to import stone into site off Fordlands Road to build up the next section of embankment.

We will continue to remove the sandy material stockpiles currently located within the proposed Persimmon residential area. A banksman will be present to ensure the safety of the public walking down Germany Lane by stopping the wagons to let pedestrians pass.

We do not anticipate any disruption to traffic using the A19 or Fordlands Road but please be aware of stone deliveries using the site entrances off Fordlands Road.

Towards the end of the next 2 weeks you may see the erection of advance notice road works signs on the A19. These signs are erected 1 to 2 weeks in advance of road works commencing to warn motorists to expect some disruption.

Details of these works will be provided in our next newsletter.

Please be assured that the different areas of works will be securely fenced at all times to ensure the safety of the public.

We will be receiving further deliveries of stone to site this week. Each delivery will be guided into site by one of our employees once traffic and pedestrians are clear from the site entrance. Please be patient if you are held up for a short time whilst these manoeuvres take place.

Pedestrians will be given right of way along the footpaths of Fordlands Road but please be aware of deliveries using the entrances to site off Fordlands Road on occasion.
