Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer at the Crichton room, West Offices, Station Rise, York between the hours of 10am and 4pm on any day after the date of this notice (except Saturday 30 March 2019 and Sunday 31 March 2019), but not later than 4pm on Wednesday 3 April 2019.

Nomination papers may be obtained from the Returning Officer on the dates and times aforesaid at the Crichton room, West Offices, Station Rise, York and who will, at the request of any elector for the area, prepare a nomination paper for signature.

If the election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday 2 May 2019**.

Electors should note the last day for applications to request a postal vote or re-direction of a postal vote or cancel an existing postal vote or proxy appointment is 5pm on Monday 15 April 2019. The last day for new applications to vote by proxy is 5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2019.

Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or work/service must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Constantine room, West Offices, Station Rise, York by 5pm on Thursday 2 May 2019. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station after 5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2019.
