During the past two weeks we have been installing kerbs and gullies to the next section of the spine road to the east of Fordlands Road.

The brickwork walls to the retaining wall parapets have continued to the west of Fordlands Road.

We have commenced excavating for the foundations for the new brickwall wall that ties into the A19.

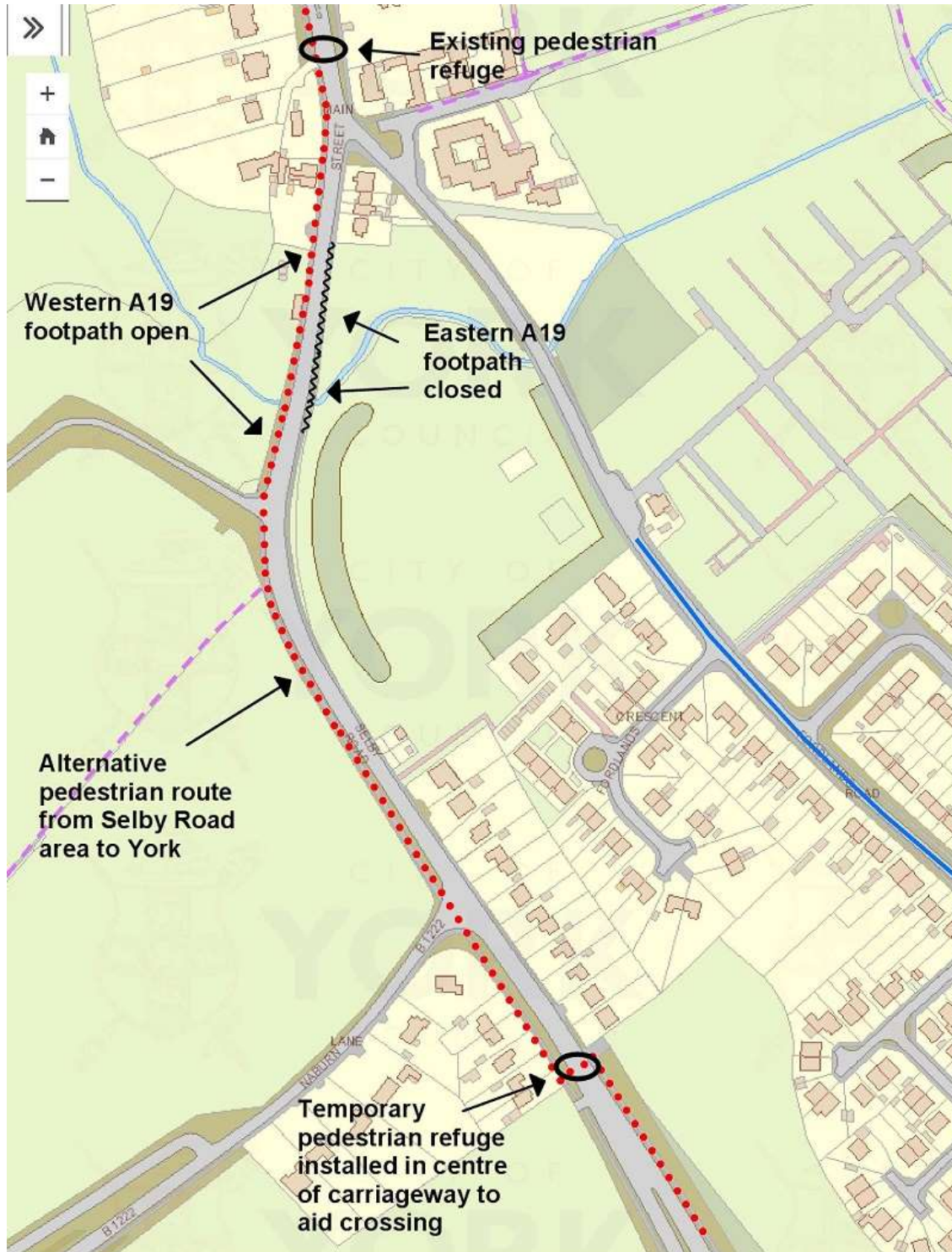
Northern Gas have continued their work to locate the medium pressure gas main on the A19.
